

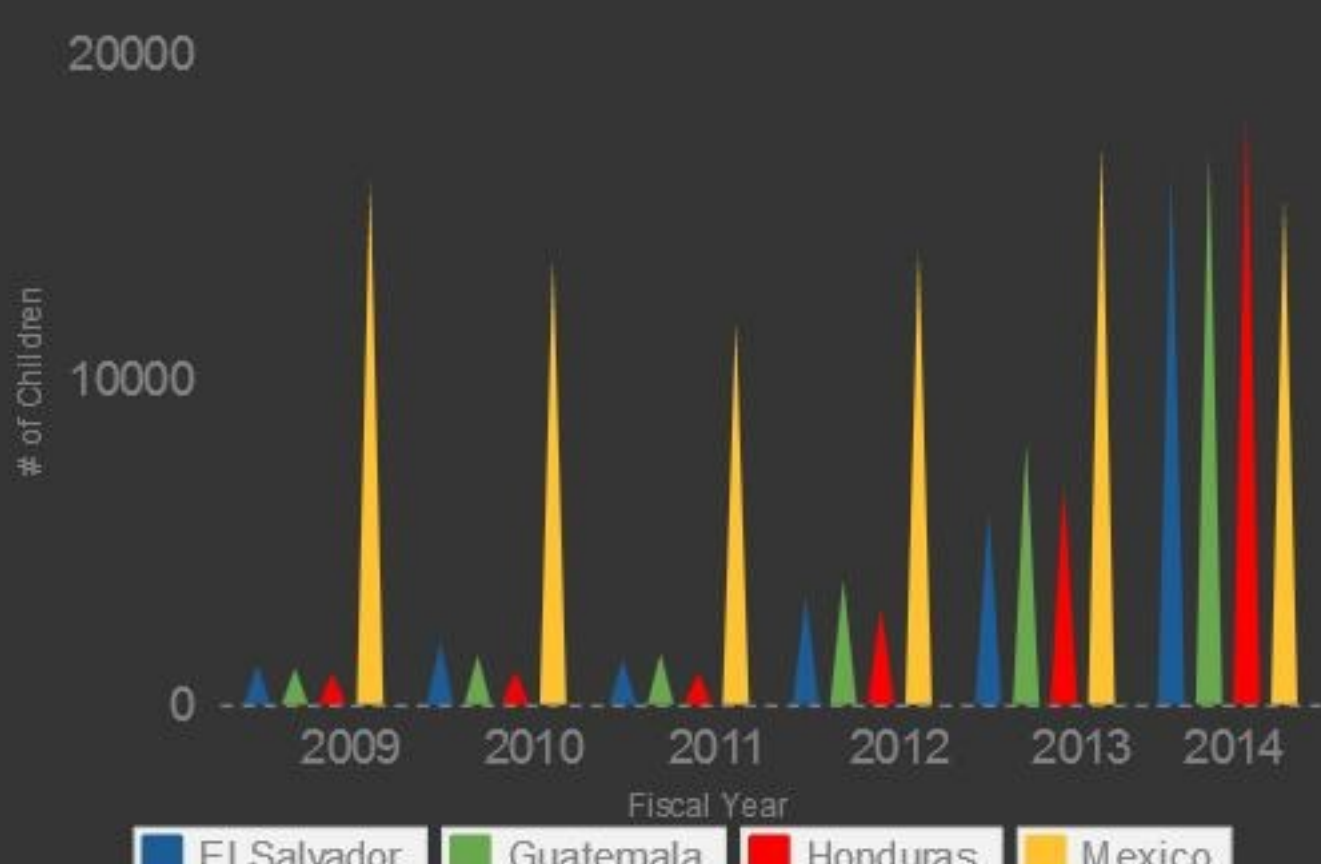


# Border Patrol Statistics 2014



## Unaccompanied Migrant Children Encounters by Country, 2009-2014

In the past 5 years there has been a huge increase in the number of unaccompanied minors encountered along the U.S.-Mexico border. The spike in numbers caught international media attention and quickly became a topic of political, economic and social debate. In 2015 the U.S. Customs and Border Patrol released statistics on the unaccompanied child migrants.

### Top 3- Border Sector Statistics

1. Rio Grande Sector
2. Tucson Sector
3. Laredo Sector



Comprised 90% of all migrant children encounters in 2014.

Rio Grande 65%, Tucson 19%, Laredo 6% of the total number of child encounters in 2014.
