He has over 30 years of experience in the energy and petroleum sectors, and his previous positions include chief executive officer of Algeria Oman Fertilizer Company, and president and chief executive officer of Sindh Engro Coal Mining Company. While at Engro, he led the development and execution of major diversification and expansion projects.

WILLIAM B. MILAM is a Senior Scholar at the Woodrow Wilson Center. A career diplomat, he retired from the U.S. Foreign Service in 2001, but was recalled after September 11th to help establish the multilateral mechanism for the reconstruction of Afghanistan.
