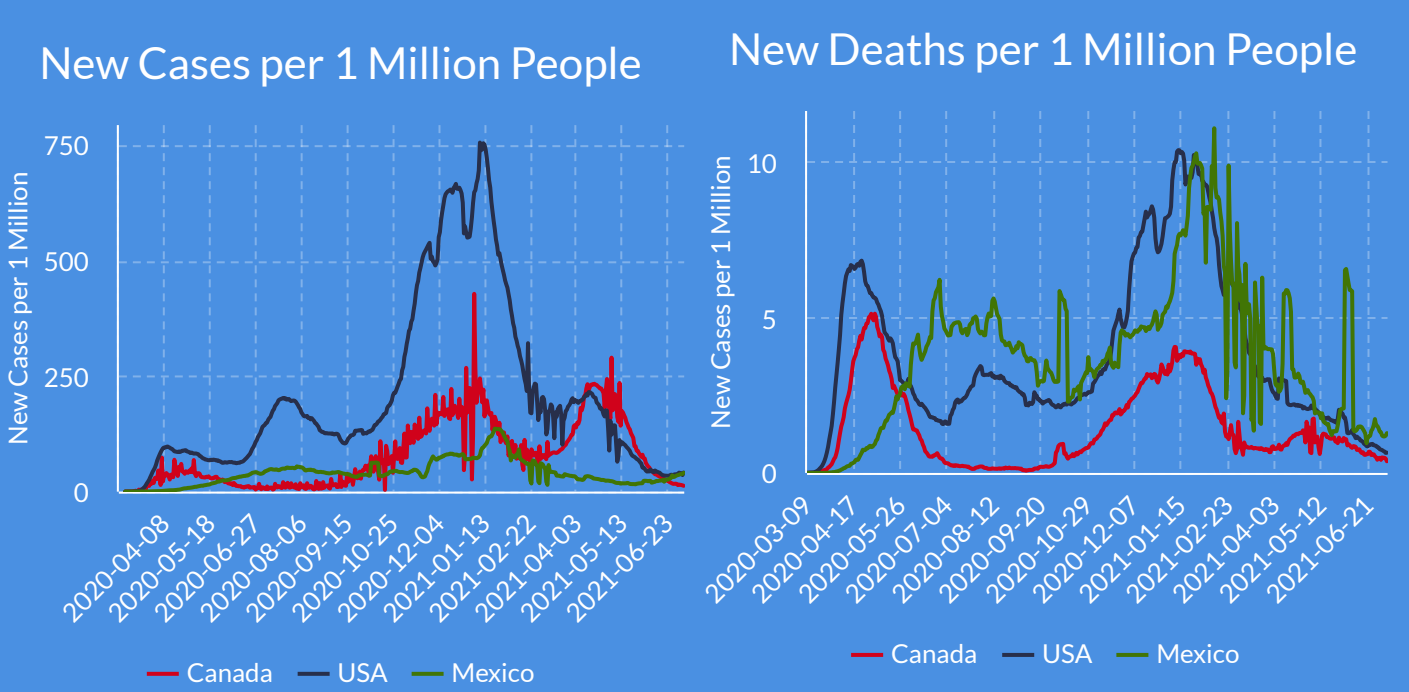

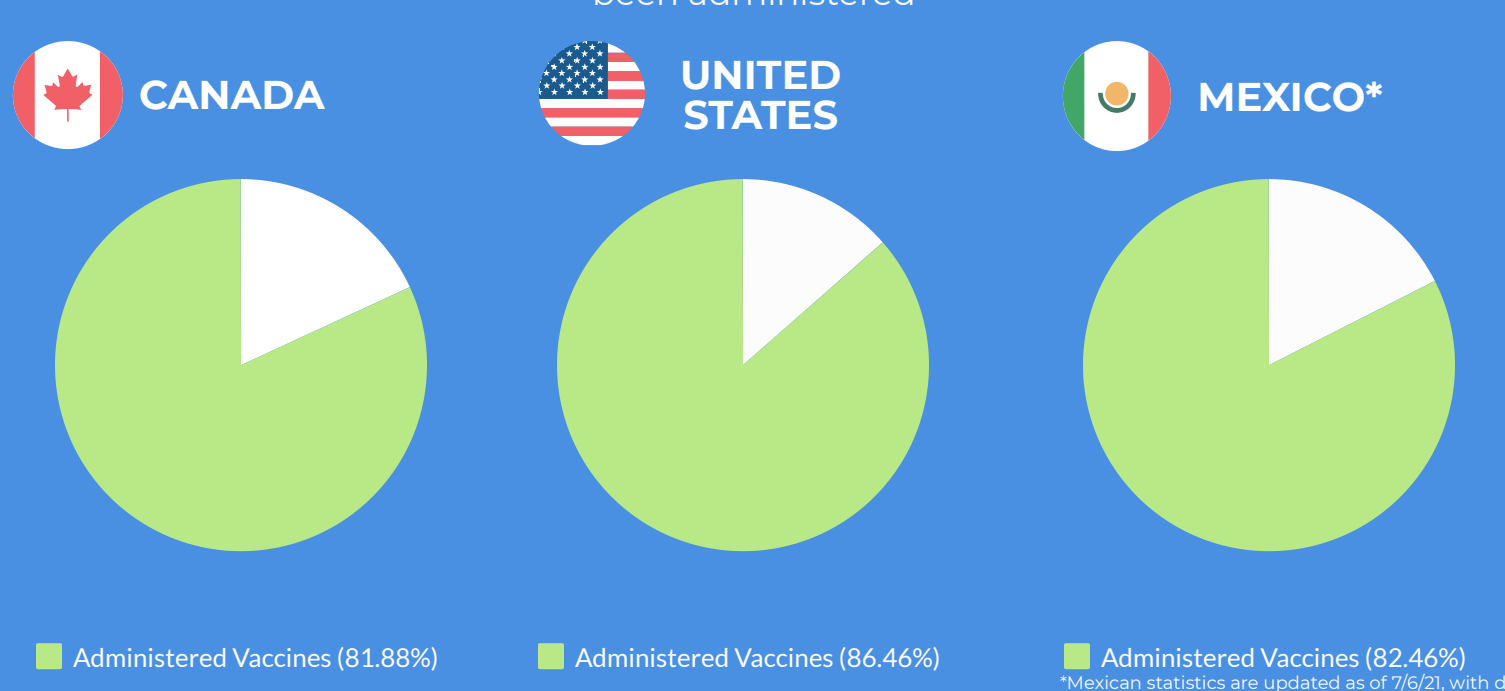
New COVID-19 Cases and Deaths per 1 Million People



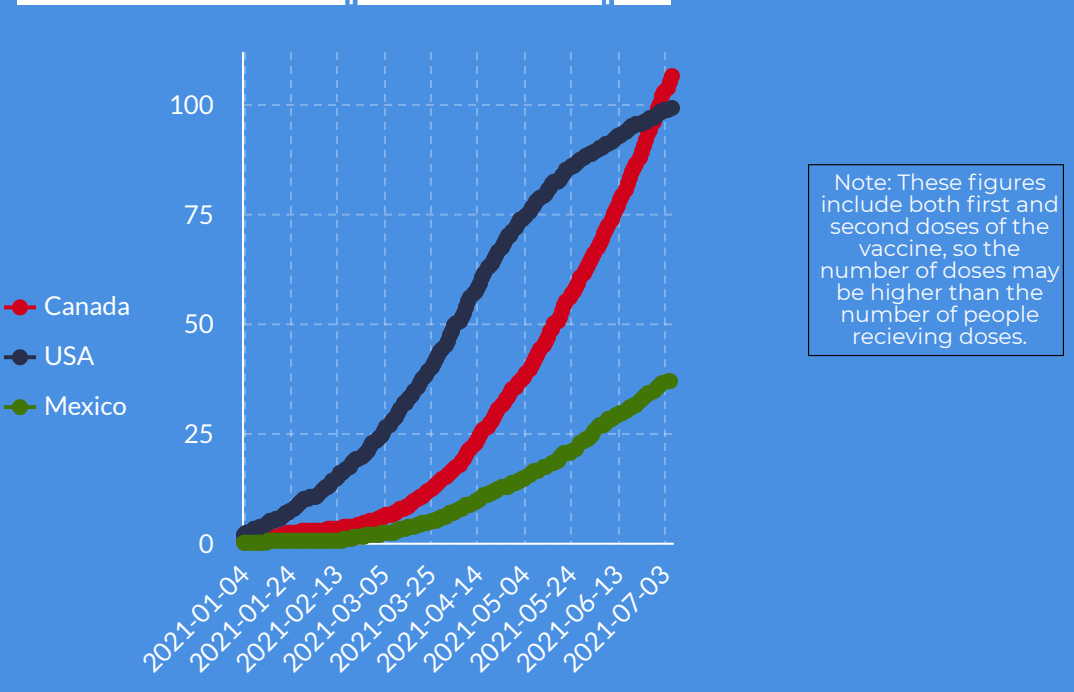
Comparison of COVID-19 Vaccination Efforts

Percentage of Vaccines Administered

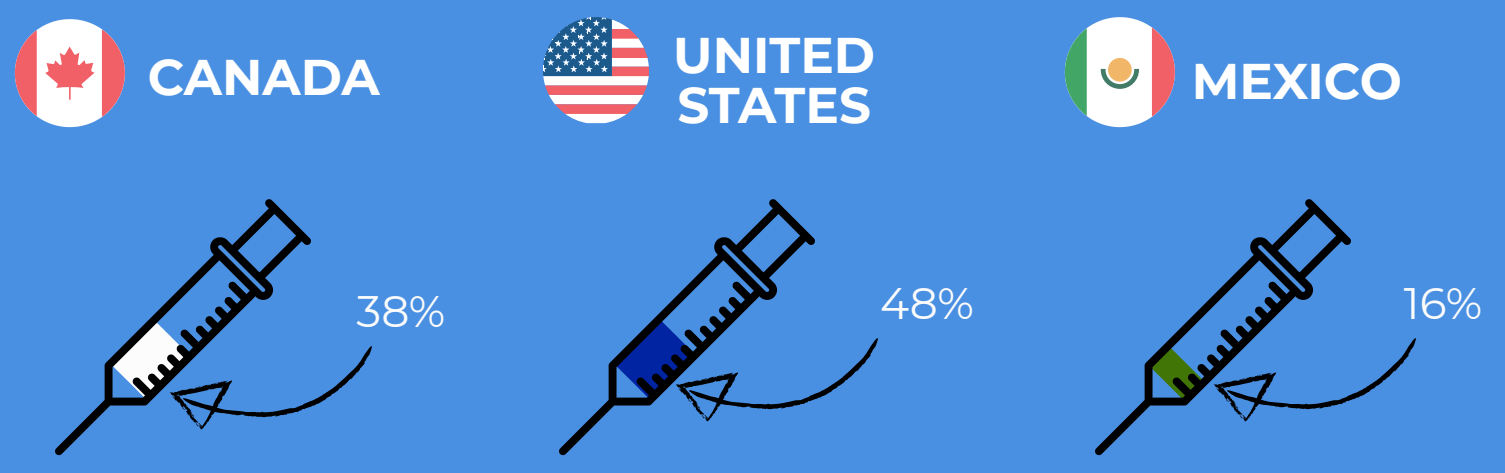
Shows the percentage of vaccines at distribution sites that have been administered



Vaccine Doses per 100 People

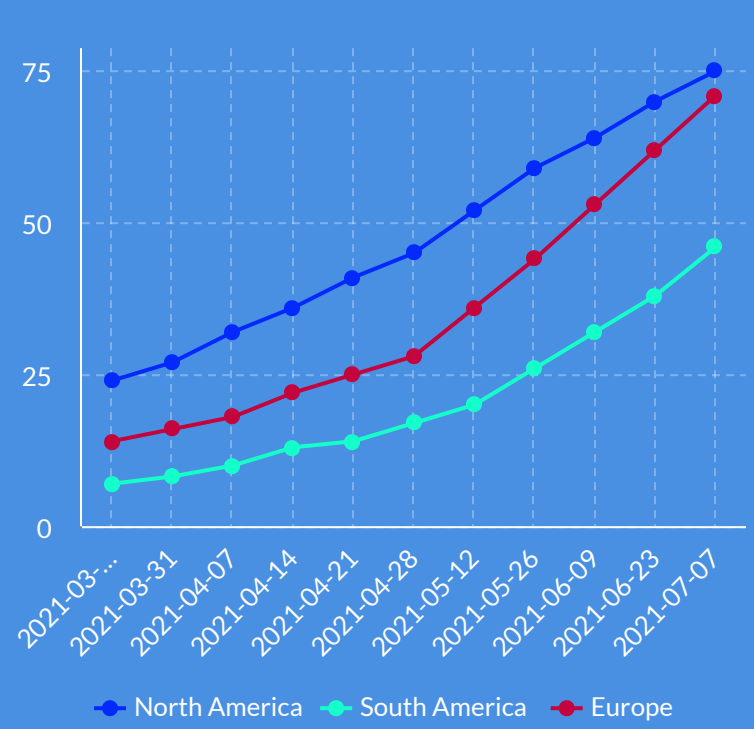


Percentage of Country Fully Vaccinated



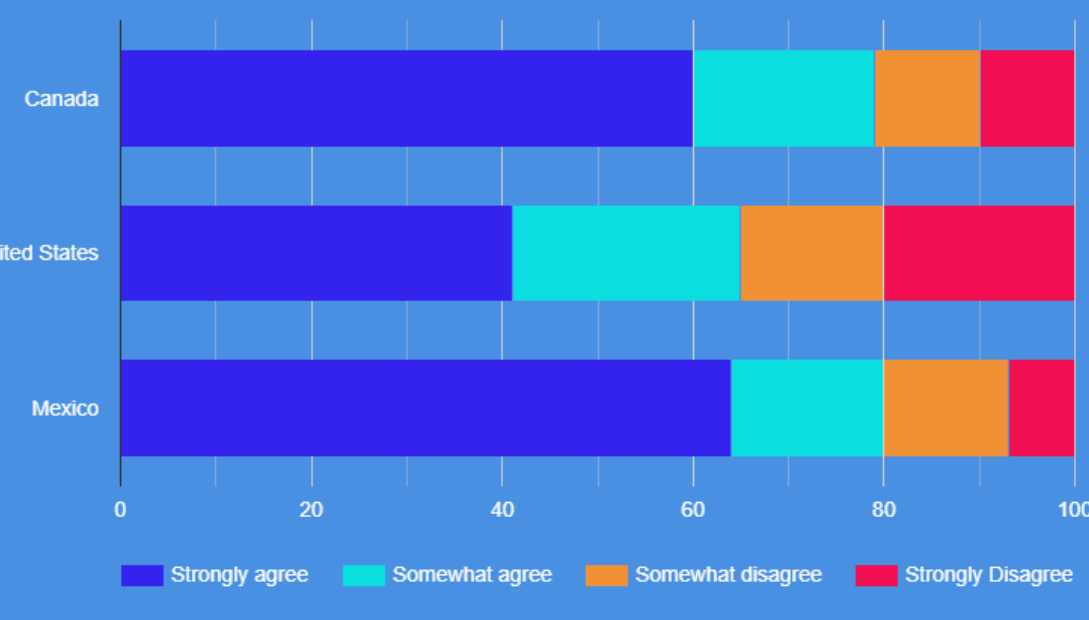
Vaccination Rates in North America vs Other Regions

Vaccination Roll Out Goals

Availability Available to all Canadian adults as of April 2021	Availability Available to all American adults as of April 19, 2021	Availability Available to all Mexican adults as of October 2021
Coverage 100% coverage of the adult population by the end of the third quarter of 2021	Coverage 70% of adult population to have one vaccine by July 4, 2021. This goal was not achieved and now the U.S. has transitioned to smaller, community-based vaccination sites.	Coverage 100% coverage of the adult population by the end of 2021
